The goal of the bungee run is to reach the finish with rubber ropes attached to hip straps, and children can roll over the meadow as part of the giant people ball.

To make sure each child will remember this special day, every little guest can have a lovely picture taken in the photo box and even get an airbrush tattoo. The preschools and schools complete the offerings with their own education booths. Here the children can learn many things related to the natural sciences.

#### A festival with a tradition

Albert Berner still remembers when children's festivals were celebrated in Künzelsau during his childhood: "We used to have a consul who organized such a party every few years, and I wanted to revive this tradition.
